~ THIS IS ONLY FOR SENIOR RESIDENTS and those who need assistance with pickup. Please call Eric Lang (206-0396), DPW Supervisor, to schedule pickup.

**Saturday, JUNE 6, 8:00am - 12:00pm**

~ Clearly labeled dumpsters are provided at the Village DPW Barn, Rich Street. All items must be delivered, separated, and deposited into the correct dumpster per the following:

- ✓ Each Village household is limited to disposal of **two** major appliances (stove, hot water heater, washer, dryer, refrigerator, etc.) Refrigerators **must have doors and Freon removed prior to disposal.**
- ✓ Metal must be separated and deposited in the dumpster labeled "For Metal Only."
- ✓ Proof of Village residency may be requested by anyone disposing of items. Please bring your driver's license and/or a piece of mail (with your name on it) that was delivered to your Village address.
- ✓ None of the following items may be disposed of in the dumpsters provided on cleanup days:
  - **hazardous waste** (asbestos, pathological/infectious wastes, etc.)
  - **liquid waste** (motor oil, paints, antifreeze, pool chemicals, acids, poisons, etc.)
  - **yard waste** (leaves, limbs, trees, stumps, etc.)
  - **radioactive waste**
  - **sludges**
  - **demolition waste** (wood, sheet rock, shingles, tar paper, etc.)
  - **industrial waste**
  - **explosives** (gas cylinders, etc.)
  - **tires**
  - **batteries**
  - **household garbage** (this is for your weekly garbage service)
  - **recyclable products** (newspapers, glass, cans, plastics, etc.)

- ✓ **NYS Disposal Ban/Disposal of Electronics:**  
As of January 1, 2015 consumers may no longer dispose of certain types of electronic equipment in landfills, waste-to-energy facilities, trash, or at curbside for trash pickup.
- ✓ NYS Department of Environmental Conservation (<http://www.dec.ny.gov/chemical/66872.html>) has more information on how to recycle electronics & what electronics are included in the Disposal Ban. Here are a few locations where Tioga County residents can still recycle electronics:
  - **Waterman Conservation Center**
    - 403 Hilton Road, Apalachin
    - Mon-Fri (9am-4pm) & Sat (10am-4pm)
    - goes in the white shed in the parking lot
    - no TVs, no monitors
    - Cost: free
  - **Staples**
    - 3701 Vestal Parkway, Vestal
    - 607.797.2524
    - accept all brands
    - limit of six (6) items
    - Cost: free
  - **Best Buy**
    - 3209 Vestal Parkway, Vestal
    - 607.777.1489
    - recycle all brands of electronics
    - no TVs larger than 42 inches
