

ANNUAL VILLAGE CLEANUP DAYS - Village Residents Only Friday, JUNE 5, 8:00am - 3:30pm

~ THIS IS ONLY FOR SENIOR RESIDENTS and those who need assistance with pickup. Please call Eric Lang (206-0396), DPW Supervisor, to schedule pickup.

Saturday, JUNE 6, 8:00am - 12:00pm ~ Clearly labeled dumpsters are provided at the Village DPW Barn, Rich Street. All items must be delivered, separated, and deposited into the correct dumpster per the following:

- ✓ Each Village household is limited to disposal of two major appliances (stove, hot water heater, washer, dryer, refrigerator, etc.) Refrigerators must have doors and Freon removed prior to disposal.
- ✓ Metal must be separated and deposited in the dumpster labeled "For Metal Only."
- ✓ Proof of Village residency may be requested by anyone disposing of items. Please bring your driver's license and/or a piece of mail (with your name on it) that was delivered to your Village address.
- ✓ None of the following items may be disposed of in the dumpsters provided on cleanup days:
 - hazardous waste (asbestos, pathological/infectious wastes, etc.)
 - > liquid waste (motor oil, paints, antifreeze, pool chemicals, acids, poisons, etc.)
 - > yard waste (leaves, limbs, trees, stumps, etc.)
 - ➤ radioactive waste
 - sludaes
 - demolition waste (wood, sheet rock, shingles, tar paper, etc.)
 - industrial waste
 - > explosives (gas cylinders, etc.)
 - ➤ tires
 - > batteries
 - > household garbage (this is for your weekly garbage service)
 - recyclable products (newspapers, glass, cans, plastics, etc.)



Remember the Rules for the "Road"

Brush must be bundled Bundles must be no more than 6 inches in diameter

Bundles must be light enough for one person to lift easily

Do not put leaves or grass clippings out for pickup This pickup is for BRUSH ONLY

Please remember that your dog (s) must be on a lease and controlled 🔎 by the owner/walker at all tímes. Also, íf they poop, you scoop! These are health, as well as safety, requirements.

- ✓ NYS Disposal Ban/Disposal of Electronics: As of January 1, 2015 consumers may no longer dispose of certain types of electronic equipment in landfills, waste-to-energy facilities, trash, or at curbside for trash pickup.

 - goes in the white shed in the parking lot
 - no TVs, no monitors
 - Cost: free

 - accept all brands
 - limit of six (6) items
 - Cost: free
 - > Best Buy
 - 3209 Vestal Parkway, Vestal
 - 607.777.1489
 - recycle all brands of electronics
 - no TVs larger than 42 inches
