Brush Pick-up September 10, October 1, and November 5

All brush must be **bundled**, **wrapped**, **no more than 6 inches in diameter** and, light enough for one person to lift easily. This pickup is for **BRUSH ONLY**, no leaves or grass clippings.

Water conservation tip:

Water gardens and outdoor plants early in the morning. You'll need less water, since cooler morning temperatures mean losing less water to evaporation. It's not a great idea to water in the evenings, since this can promote mold growth.
