Village Clean-up Days

Friday, June 7, 8:00am - 3:30pm ~ ONLY for seniors and residents needing assistance. Call 607-659-7966 to schedule.
Saturday, June 8, 8:00am - 12:00pm ~ Clearly labeled dumpsters will be provided at the Village DPW Barn on Rich Street.
All items must be delivered, separated, and deposited into the correct dumpster per the following guidelines:

- ✓ Each Village household is limited to disposal of **two (2)** major appliances (stove, hot water heater, washer, dryer, refrigerator, etc.). Refrigerators **must have doors and Freon removed** prior to disposal.
- ✓ All metal must be separated and deposited into the dumpster labeled "For Metal Only."
- ✓ Proof of Village residency may be requested by anyone disposing of items. Please bring your driver's license and/or a piece of mail with your name on it delivered to your Village address.
- ✓ None of the following items may be disposed of in the dumpsters provided on clean-up days:
 - **hazardous waste** (including pathological and infectious wastes)
 - **liquid waste** (motor oil, paints, antifreeze, pool chemicals, acids, poisons, etc.)
 - **yard waste** (including leaves, limbs, trees, or stumps)
 - **radioactive waste**
 - **sludges**
 - **demolition waste** (wood, sheet rock, shingles, tar paper, etc.)
 - **industrial waste**
 - **explosives** (including gas cylinders)
 - **tires**
 - **batteries**
 - **household garbage** (this is to be picked up by your garbage service)
 - **recyclable products** (newspapers, glass, cans, plastics, etc.)



BRUSH PICKUP

April 15 ~ May 6 & 20

June 3, July 1

- ✓ This pick-up is for **brush ONLY**
- ✓ **Brush must be bundled**
- ✓ Bundles must be no more than six inches in diameter
- ✓ Bundles must be light enough for one person to lift easily
- ✓ Do not put leaves or grass clippings out for pick-up
